Capacity Building Program

We started off 2014 by rolling out our newly redesigned capacity building program, which provides our grantees with the opportunity to supplement their grant funds with learning opportunities that will help them to build long-term sustainability. By combining a series of convenings, webinars, and individualized technical assistance, we aim to increase knowledge of nonprofit management for our Native nonprofit grantees and small business and arts-specific content for our Native artist grantees. In June we hired Maria Griffin as our new Program Coordinator and launched our Spokane satellite office in partnership with Empire Health Foundation. We are currently located at 1023 West Riverside Avenue in downtown Spokane and will be moving to Empire Health Foundation's newly remodeled office space in the coming months. We are thrilled to be able to have an office in Spokane as it allows Potlatch Fund staff to better serve the Eastern Washington, Eastern Oregon, and Tribal communities of Idaho by having a local presence.

Grant Opportunities

In 2014 Potlatch Fund continued to provide small grants to support Intertribal Canoe Journey, Native Arts, Community Building, and Language Preservation and Education. With recommendations from our grantmaking committees and Board of Directors, we made 68 grants totaling \$244,200 in support of Native-led programs and projects across our Pacific Northwest region of Washington, Oregon, Idaho, and Montana. We also experienced a surge of applications that helped us to achieve our goal of making grants in all four states across our region with substantial increases to Montana and Oregon. In late January, we will publish our grant program calendar with all RFP release dates and deadlines for the year through our enewsletter and on our


