The silent auction will be limited to 25 items and highlight:

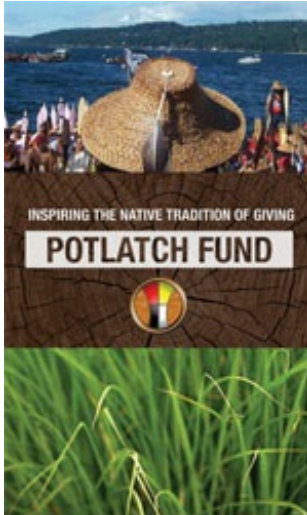
- Native artists from our service area,

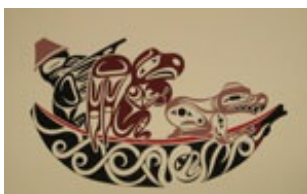
